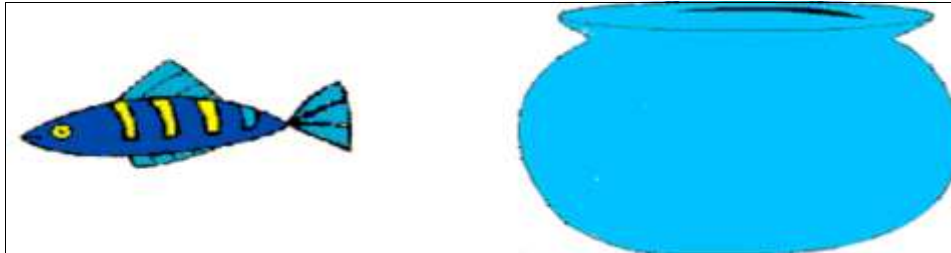
Skunks are opportunists at heart—they're mainly attracted to low-hanging fruit, garbage and pet food left out at night, as well as convenient denning sites, such as wood & rock piles, elevated sheds, openings under concrete slabs and crawl spaces. Preventive measures, such as removing attractants will decrease the likelihood of an unpleasant skunk encounter, this includes securing trash. Skirting around your home should be inspected, so they don't have access to enter. Citrus peels, such as orange or lemon are said to be quite effective. Sprinkle these around where the skunk likes to go and it will start to avoid those areas.
