Spring is here.....

Time to clean up your home and your property!

We want to keep our park in tip-top shape and inviting for our residents and those who will choose Homestead Run to become their next home.

Time is getting near for trimming shrubs and trees, pulling weeds and removing any items in your yard that are an eyesore or no longer needed or wanted. Check the outside of your home for any damage that may

have occurred during the winter and have repairs made.

Shrub & Tree Trimmings, Branches & Small Diameter Logs:

Beginning the week of April 3rd the Township will start curbside pickup of shrub, tree trimmings & branches. Branches must be less than 4" in diameter and all material must be in lengths of 4' or less and weigh less than 50 lbs. DO NOT BAG BRUSH OR TIE TWIGS/BRANCHES. Put material to be picked up at the curb before 6:30 am on April 3rd. Collections will end on April 14th.

Leaf collection:

Leaf pickup will be ONCE during the week of April 17th. Only leaves in plastic bags will be collected. Have leaf bags curbside by 6:30 am on the day of pickup.

Sometimes the Township is ahead of schedule. You should put bagged leaves to the curb before your scheduled week begins. They may come early. However, they will still come again during your scheduled collection week.

Leaves are not permitted in the landfill. If you miss the collection, they must be brought to the Recycling Convenience Center on Church Rd. Monday—Saturday 7:30am to 3:00pm
