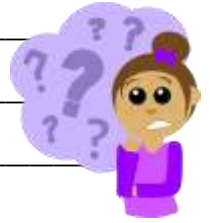

Winter Reminders:

- When the snow falls, be sure you do not have any car parked on the street. Cars will be towed at the owner's expense. We really don't want to do that!
- Once the snow has been removed from the roads, it will be at the discretion of the Maintenance Team if and when the aprons will be opened. Aprons are opened as a courtesy.
- Do not try to contact the snow removal team while they are plowing the roads, they cannot hear over the loud equipment, and are not permitted to do "side" work while taking care of the Park.
- Below freezing temperatures are expected throughout the week. It is strongly advised you run your water, maintain adequate heat and open your cabinet doors to allow heat to penetrate your pipes. There is no guarantee your pipes won't freeze, but this will reduce the chance of a freeze up occurring.

Be prepared:

- * Store drinking water, first aid kit, canned/no-cook food, non-electric can opener, radio, flashlight and extra batteries where you can get them easily, even in the dark.
- * Keep cars and other vehicles fueled and in good repair, with a winter emergency kit in each.
- * Experts recommend wearing several layers of loose-fitting lightweight, warm clothing rather than one layer of heavy clothing.
- * Wear a hat. Cover your mouth with a scarf to protect your lungs from extremely cold air. Wear sturdy, waterproof boots in snow. Watch carefully for ice accumulation on walks and driveways.
