Your recycling day is on Monday ..

Your leaf collection weeks start October 30th and November 27th.

****By Monday 6:30am - have bagged leaves to curbside****

Only leaves in plastic bags will be collected.

Leaves are not permitted landfill. If you miss the curbside collection, bagged or loose leaves must be brought to the Recycling Convenience Center (located on Church Road, east of North Bay Avenue).



Hours are 7:30am to 3:00pm Monday through Saturday.

“REVISED INFO! Due to a significant increase in e-waste disposal fees, the Township stopped accepting recycled electronics on October 1, 2016. Toms River residents had been forced to take those items to the Ocean County Recycling Facility in Lakewood. Now, they can bring them to the Township Recycling Center, free of charge year-round. Electronic items may be dropped off at the

Toms River Recycling Convenience Center, located at 1672 Church Rd, Monday through Friday from 7:30 a.m. to 3 p.m..
