














CRANBERRY SAUCE

In memory of Queen Elizabeth II. This recipe is a simple classic favorite recipe of the Queen's and given to the royal family and staff as a gift after Christmas dinner. Wishing everyone a peaceful and merry Christmas.

> PREP TIME: 5 mins **COOK TIME: 15 mins TOTAL TIME: 20 mins SERVINGS 9 servings** YIELD 2 1/4 cups

The recipe calls for a cup of water. You can easily substitute that with 1/2 cup of orange juice and 1/2 cup of water if you want to increase the orange note in the sauce (cranberries and oranges play well together!)

You can also reduce the sugar if you want. Start out with half as much and add more if you think it needs it. If you use less sugar, reduce the amount of water you add as well.

INGREDIENTS

- 1 cup (200g) sugar
- 1 cup (250ml) water
- 4 cups (one 12-ounce package) fresh cranberries
- Optional: pecans, orange zest, raisins, currants, blueberries, cinnamon, nutmeg, allspice

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Bring the water and sugar to a boil.
- Add cranberries and reduce to a simmer for approximately 10 minutes. Berries will begin to pop!
- Once reduced, feel free to add any of the options for a nice kick!
- 4. Pour into a mason jar or bowl and allow to cool to room temperature before refrigerating.


