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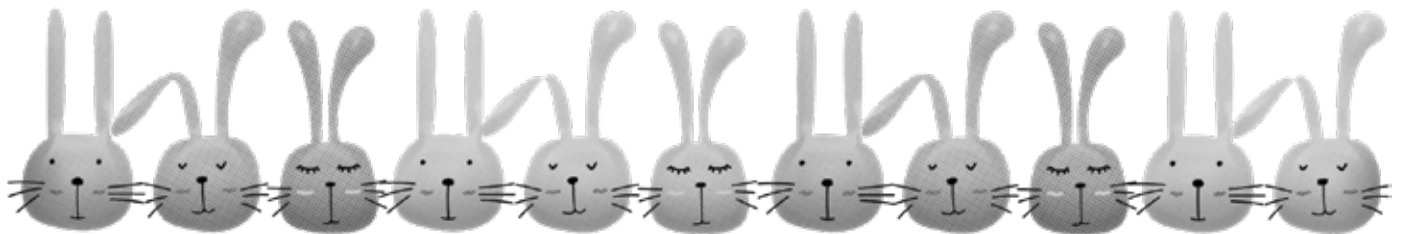

SICILIAN SKILLET CHICKEN

INGREDIENTS

- 1 tbsp. extra-virgin olive oil
- 6 bone-in, skin-on chicken thighs
- Salt
- freshly ground black pepper
- 2 cloves garlic, crushed
- 1 tbsp. fresh thyme leaves
- 1 tsp. crushed chili flakes
- 200 ml chicken stock
- 100 ml heavy cream
- 30 g chopped sun-dried tomatoes
- 30 g freshly grated Parmesan
- freshly torn basil, for serving

INSTRUCTIONS

1. 1. Preheat oven to 375*. In a large oven-safe pan over medium-high heat, heat oil. Season chicken generously with salt and pepper and sear, skin-side down, until golden, 4 to 5 minutes per side. Transfer chicken to a plate and pour off half the fat from pan.
2. 2. Return pan to medium heat and add garlic, thyme, and chili flakes. Cook until fragrant, 1 minute, then stir in stock, heavy cream, sun-dried tomatoes, and Parmesan and season with more salt. Bring to a simmer, then return chicken to pan, skin-side up.
3. 3. Transfer pan to oven and bake until chicken is cooked through (and juices run clear when chicken is pierced with a knife), 17 to 20 minutes.
4. 4. Garnish with basil and serve.

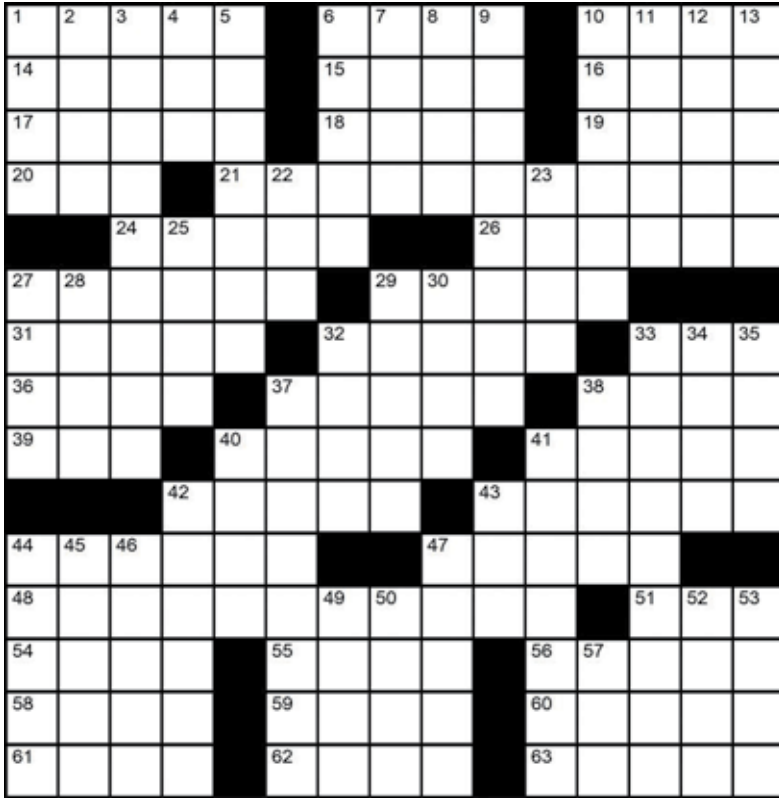
