# TOWNSHIP OF TOMS RIVER DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS <u>ANNOUNCEMENT</u>

Homestead Run will be changing to ROBO cans. They will be delivered the last week of January between the 24<sup>th</sup> and the 28<sup>th</sup>. It will be a multiple day roll-out, weather-permitting.

Your Sanitation Collect Day is changing to the first week of February 2022. It will be moving to every FRIDAY effective February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022. It will be collected every Friday from then on. Your first new sanitation collection day will be Friday, February 4<sup>th</sup>, 2022.

Robo recycling will begin in February as well. The schedule will be changing to every other Monday. We are awaiting the date of the official start.

All items must be placed in your new robo cans for collections starting Friday, February 4<sup>th</sup>. Older cans will not be used. You are not permitted to leave bags on the curb. Everything must go inside of your robo cans.

On Friday, March 4<sup>th</sup>, we will be coming through the neighborhood to collect old and unwanted sanitation or recycling cans. Leave them empty on the curb to be recycled.

You may call 732-255-1000 for extra sanitation pick ups for any items that do not fit into your robo can, as always. Those extra pick-ups will occur the Monday following your garbage pick-up.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Toms River Public Works will be distributing flyers about this change in the neighborhood on Tuesday, January 18<sup>th</sup>, 2022. We have been granted permission from the Homestead Run Business Office.
